1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state of Iowa to the higher education facilities
 3 commission for each fiscal year of the biennium beginning
 4 July 1, 1971 and ending June 30, 1973, the following amounts,
 5 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the
 6 following designated purposes:

14 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
 15 of the commission are appropriated for the purpose set forth
 16 in such federal grants or receipts.

17 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
 18 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
 19 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
 20 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
 21 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
 22 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. The
 23 higher education facilities commission may make application
 24 to the committees on appropriations for the reappropriation
 25 of any funds that do revert, or probably will revert upon
 26 the dates herein set and the respective committees on
 27 appropriations or a subcommittee thereof shall hold a hearing
 28 upon the application while the general assembly is in regular
 29 session. In all other respects the provisions of section
 30 eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to
 31 appropriations made for the first fiscal year of such biennium.
 32 Unencumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made
 33 for the second fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject
 34 to section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

35 Sec. 4. When any of the laws of this state are in con-

1 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern
2 for the biennium.
