1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the educational radio and television facility
3 board for each fiscal year of the biennium beginning July
4 1, 1971 and ending June 30, 1973, the following amounts, or
5 so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the
6 purposes designated:

18 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the
19 state to the educational radio and television facility board
20 for the fiscal biennium commencing July 1, 1971 and ending
21 June 30, 1973, the sum of thirty-two thousand five hundred
22 (32,500) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for
23 the acquisition and operation of equipment to be made avail-
24 able by the Black Hawk broadcasting company.

25 Sec. 3. The educational radio and television facility
26 board, the governor, and the state comptroller may accept
27 federal or private grants to the state or accept as a gift
28 any facilities or real property to be used in connection with
29 the funds appropriated by this Act.

30 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
31 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
32 unobligated balances of appropriations made by section one
33 (1) of this Act for the first fiscal year of the biennium
34 commencing July 1, 1971 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert
35 to the state treasury and to the credit of the fund from which

1 appropriated. The educational radio and television facility
2 board may make application to the committees on appropriations
3 for the reappropriation of any funds that do revert, or
4 probably will revert upon the dates herein set and the
5 respective committees on appropriations or a subcommittee
6 thereof shall hold a hearing upon the application while the
7 general assembly is in regular session. In all other respects
8 the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33)
9 of the Code shall apply to appropriations made for the first
10 fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered or unobligated
11 balances of appropriations made for the second fiscal year
12 of such biennium shall be subject to section eight point
13 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

14 Sec. 5. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict
15 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for
16 the biennium.
