A BILL FOR

1 An Act providing a penalty for the unlawful use of temporary
2 and instructional driving permits.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point two
5 hundred sixteen (321.216), Code 1971, is amended as follows:

6 321.216 UNLAWFUL USE OF LICENSE. It is a misdemeanor,
7 punishable as provided in section 321.482 unless another
8 punishment is otherwise provided, for any person:

9 1. To display or cause or permit to be displayed or have
10 in his possession any canceled, revoked, suspended, fictitious
11 or fraudulently altered temporary driver's permit, temporary
12 instruction permit, operator's license, or chauffeur's license.

13 2. To lend his temporary driver's permit, temporary
14 instruction permit, operator's license, or chauffeur's license
15 to any other person or knowingly permit the use thereof by
16 another.

17 3. To display or represent as one's own any temporary
18 driver's permit, temporary instruction permit, operator's
19 license, or chauffeur's license not issued to him.

20 4. To fail or refuse to surrender to the department upon
21 its lawful demand any temporary driver's permit, temporary
22 instruction permit, operator's license, or chauffeur's license
23 which has been suspended, revoked, or canceled.

24 5. To use a false or fictitious name in any application
25 for an a temporary driver's permit, temporary instruction

1 permit, operator's license, or chauffeur's license or to
2 knowingly make a false statement or to knowingly conceal a
3 material fact or otherwise commit a fraud in any such
4 application.

5 6. To permit any unlawful use of ~~an~~ a temporary driver's
6 permit, temporary instruction permit, operator's license,
7 or chauffeur's license issued to him.

8 EXPLANATION

9 This bill makes it a misdemeanor to falsely use, or allow
10 to be used, a temporary driver's or instruction permit.
