A BILL FOR

1 An Act to legalize and validate the proceedings of the City
2 Council of the City of DeWitt, Iowa, in connection with an
3 election for the issuance of swimming pool bonds and declar-
4 ing the validity of said election and that bonds issued pur-
5 suant to and authorized thereby shall constitute valid and
6 binding obligations of said City.

1 WHEREAS, it appears from the records of the City of DeWitt,
2 Iowa, that a special election held in and for said City on
3 November 3, 1970, the proposition of issuing bonds of said
4 City in the amount of thirty thousand dollars for the purpose
5 of providing funds to pay the cost of the expansion of the
6 existing DeWitt Swimming Pool was approved by more than sixty
7 percent of the total number of votes cast for and against
8 said proposition, and in reliance upon said election said
9 City Council proposes to authorize and provide for the issuance
10 of Swimming Pool Bonds to the amount and for the purpose
11 aforesaid; and

12 WHEREAS, doubts have arisen concerning the validity and
13 legal sufficiency of said election and said bonds and it is
14 deemed advisable to put such doubts and all others that might
15 arise concerning same forever at rest; NOW, THEREFORE,

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

17 Section 1. That all proceedings heretofore taken by the
18 City Council of the City of DeWitt, Iowa, preliminary to and
19 in connection with the election on said bonds held in said
20 City on November 3, 1970, and said election are hereby legal-
21 ized, validated and confirmed and swimming pool bonds to be
22 issued, sold and delivered pursuant to and by authority of
23 said election shall constitute valid and binding obligations
24 of said City.

25 Section 2. This Act being of immediate importance shall
26 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
27 publication in The DeWitt Observer, a newspaper published
28 at DeWitt, Iowa, and The Clinton Herald, a newspaper published
29 at Clinton, Iowa, without expense to the State.

30 EXPLANATION

31 This bill legalizes proceedings under which the city of
32 DeWitt, Iowa, held an election and authorized the issuance
33 of bonds to finance the expansion of the DeWitt swimming pool.
