## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution  
2 of the State of Iowa relating to the appropriation of fines  
3 as provided by law.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

5 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution  
6 of the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

7 1. Section four (4), subdivision two (2) entitled "School  
8 Funds and School Lands", of Article nine (IX) of the Consti-  
9 tution of the State of Iowa is hereby repealed.

10 2. Section four (4) of Article twelve (XII) of the Consti-  
11 tution of the State of Iowa is hereby repealed.

12 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitu-  
13 tion of the State of Iowa is hereby referred to the general  
14 assembly to be chosen at the next general election for mem-  
15 bers of the general assembly and the secretary of state is  
16 directed to cause the same to be published for three con-  
17 secutive months before the date of said election as provided  
18 by law.

### 19 EXPLANATION

20 This Resolution provides for the repeal of the constitu-  
21 tional sections which provide that all fines for breach of  
22 the penal laws are to be applied among the school districts.  
23 This repeal will not change the law on this subject since  
24 section 666.3 of the Code is an analogous section to those  
25 of the Constitution. Repeal of the Constitutional sections

1 will allow the General Assembly to change the distribution  
2 of fines in the future.
