HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution
2 of the State of Iowa repealing the prohibition against
3 lotteries in order that they may be regulated by the
4 general assembly.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7 the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

8 "Section twenty-eight (28) of Article three (III) of the
9 Constitution of the State of Iowa is hereby repealed."

10 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment, having been
11 adopted and agreed to by the Sixty-third General Assembly,
12 Second Session, thereafter duly published, and now adopted and
13 agreed to by the Sixty-fourth General Assembly in this Joint
14 Resolution, shall be submitted to the people of the state of
15 Iowa at the general election in November of the year nineteen
16 hundred seventy-two in the manner required by the Constitution
17 of the State of Iowa and the laws of the state of Iowa.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This Joint Resolution repeals the lottery prohibition in
20 the Constitution. The Joint Resolution was adopted by the
21 1970 Session of the Sixty-third General Assembly.
