### A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to money advances by county boards of  
2 supervisors to county conservation boards from money  
3 in the county general funds.

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter one  
2 hundred eleven A (111A) of the Code, during the calendar year  
3 1972 the county board of supervisors of any county having  
4 a population of at least one hundred and fifty thousand but  
5 not more than two hundred thousand persons as determined by  
6 the 1970 federal decennial census, may advance to the county  
7 conservation board from the county general fund, not to exceed  
8 fifty percent of the amount of money appropriated by the  
9 county board of supervisors to the county conservation board  
10 for the year 1972.

11 Sec. 2. This Act shall be printed in the session laws  
12 only and shall not be made a part of the permanent Code of  
13 Iowa.

14 Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force on  
15 and retroactively to January 1, 1972 after its publication  
16 in The Cedar Rapids Gazette, a newspaper published in Cedar  
17 Rapids, Iowa, and in The Marion Sentinel, a newspaper pub-  
18 lished in Marion, Iowa.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill provides that the board of supervisors may advance  
21 to the county conservation board money from the county general  
22 fund in an amount not to exceed one-half the money appro-  
23 priated to the conservation board for that year.

24 The bill only applies to counties between 150,000 and  
25 200,000 population and is effective only for the year 1972.
