A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the publication of educational and
2 scientific reports by the state archaeologist.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
4 Section 1. Section three hundred five A point two (305A.2),
5 Code 1971, is amended to read as follows:
6 305A.2 DUTIES. The state archaeologist shall have the
7 primary responsibility for the discovery, location and excava-
8 tion of archaeological sites and for the recovery, restoration
9 and preservation of archaeological remains in and for the
10 state of Iowa, and shall co-ordinate all such activities
11 through co-operation with the state highway commission, state
12 conservation commission, and other state agencies concerned
13 with archaeological salvage or the products thereof. The
14 state archaeologist may publish educational and scientific
15 reports relating to the responsibilities and duties of his
16 office.

EXPLANATION

17
18 The publication of scientific and educational reports is
19 a necessary function of the state archaeologist's office but
20 no authorization for such publication is presently provided
21 in the Code. The bill provides for such authority.
