A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the method of paying state employees.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

3 Section 1. Section eight point fifteen (8.15), Code 1971,
4 is amended to read as follows:

5 8.15 VOUCHERS. Before a warrant or equivalent shall be
6 issued for any claim payable from the state treasury, there
7 shall be filed an itemized, certified voucher which shall
8 show in detail the items of service, expense, thing furnished,
9 or contract upon which payment is sought.

10 Vouchers for postage, stamped envelopes, and postal cards
11 may be audited as soon as an order therefor is entered.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill will give the state comptroller the authority to
14 establish a system of paying state employees which would provide
15 for a bank to credit an employee's bank account with his net
16 earnings on each payday without the issuance of a warrant check
17 by the state. The state and the bank would then execute an
18 agreement for the method of making payment to the bank.
