## A BILL FOR

1 An Act to establish a chiropractic examining board fund and  
2 to increase the fee for renewal of a license to practice  
3 chiropractic.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Amend Senate File 138 as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 10, by inserting after the word  
3 "practice" the words "chiropractic or".

4 2. Page 2, by adding the following new section after  
5 line 18:

6 "Sec. 2. Section one hundred forty-seven point  
7 eighty (147.80), subsection two (2), Code 1971, is  
8 amended by adding the following new sentence:

9 'For a license to practice chiropractic issued by  
10 endorsement or under a reciprocal agreement, one hundred  
11 dollars.'"

12 3. Page 2, line 17, by striking the word  
13 "chiropractic,".

14 4. Page 2, line 32, by striking the words "calendar  
15 year" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "biennium".

16 5. By renumbering the last section.

1 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-seven point eighty  
2 (147.80), subsection seven (7), Code 1971, is amended as  
3 follows:

4 7. For the renewal of a license to practice any of the  
5 professions enumerated in the preceding subsections, one  
6 dollar; except the renewal fee of a license to practice medi-  
7 cine and surgery, osteopathic medicine and surgery, or  
8 osteopathy shall be fifteen dollars, and except the renewal  
9 fee to practice cosmetology shall be three dollars, and except  
10 the renewal fee of a license to practice pharmacy shall be  
11 twelve dollars and fifty cents, and except the renewal fee of  
12 a license to practice nursing shall be four dollars and except  
13 the renewal fee of a license to practice funeral directing and  
14 the renewal fee of a license to practice embalming shall be two  
15 dollars each, and except the renewal fee of a license to  
16 practice podiatry shall be fifteen dollars, and except the  
17 renewal fee of a license to practice optometry, chiropractic,  
18 or barbering shall be five dollars.

19 Sec. 2. Section one hundred forty-seven point one hundred  
20 three (147.103), unnumbered paragraph one (1), Code 1971, is  
21 amended as follows:

22 All fees paid to the department by practitioners of  
23 chiropractic shall be transmitted by the department to the  
24 treasurer of state who shall deposit the fees in a separate  
25 fund to be known as the chiropractic examining board fund, to  
26 be used by the chiropractic examiners to assist in administering  
27 and enforcing the laws relating to the practice of chiropractic.  
28 The fund shall be continued from year to year and the treasurer  
29 of state shall keep a separate account of the fund showing  
30 receipts and disbursements, and any remainder in the fund in  
31 excess of twenty-five thousand dollars at the end of each  
32 calendar year shall be paid into the general fund of the state.  
33 The fund shall be subject at all times to the warrant of the  
34 state comptroller, drawn upon written requisition of the chair-  
35 man of the chiropractic examiners and attested by the secretary,

1 for the payment of all salaries, per diem expense, and other  
 2 expenses necessary to administer and aid in the enforcement of  
 3 the provisions of law relating to the practice of chiropractic,  
 4 but the total expenses of the chiropractic examiners shall not  
 5 exceed the total fees collected and deposited to the credit of  
 6 the fund. Subject to the approval of the executive council, the  
 7 chiropractic examining board may employ such clerical assistance  
 8 as may be necessary to said board to perform the duties imposed  
 9 upon it by law. Payment for such assistance shall be made ~~out~~  
 10 ~~of the appropriation provided for said examining board in the~~  
 11 ~~biennial departmental appropriations~~ from the chiropractic  
 12 examining board fund. The executive council shall also furnish  
 13 said board with the necessary quarters and all articles and  
 14 supplies required for public use, and the provisions of section  
 15 147.26 shall not apply to said board.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill establishes a separate chiropractic examining  
 18 board fund into which all fees collected for the practice of  
 19 chiropractic must be paid. The bill also increases the fee  
 20 for renewal of a license to practice chiropractic from \$1 to  
 21 \$5.
