A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to vocational training and apprenticeship pro-
2 grams.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section ninety-two point nine (92.9), Code
2 1971, is amended as follows:

3 92.9 SCHOOL TRAINING PERMITTED.

4 1. The provisions of section sections 92.8 and 92.10 shall
5 not apply to pupils working under an instructor in a manual
6 training department in the public schools of the state or
7 under an instructor in a school shop, or industrial plant,
8 or in a course of vocational education approved by the board
9 for vocational education, or to apprentices provided they
10 are employed under all of the following conditions:

11 a. The pupil is enrolled in a course of study and train-
12 ing in a cooperative vocational training program under a
13 recognized state or local educational authority or in a course
14 of study in a substantially similar program conducted by a
15 private school.

16 b. The pupil is employed under a written agreement which
17 provides:

18 (1) That the work of the pupil in the occupations declared
19 particularly hazardous shall be incidental to his training.

20 (2) That the work shall be intermittent and for short
21 periods of time, and under the direct and close supervision
22 of a qualified and experienced person.

23 (3) That safety instructions shall be given by the school
24 and correlated by the employer with on-the-job training.

25 (4) That a schedule of organized and progressive work
26 processes to be performed on the job shall have been prepared.

27 Each such written agreement shall contain the name of the
28 pupil and shall be signed by the employer and the school
29 coordinator or principal. Copies of each agreement shall
30 be kept on file by both the school and the employer. The
31 exemption for the employment of pupils may be revoked in any
32 individual situation where it is found that reasonable
33 precautions have not been observed for the safety of minors
34 employed thereunder.

35 2. The provisions of section 92.8 and 92.10 shall not

1 apply to apprentices provided they are employed under all
2 of the following conditions:

3 1a. The apprentice is employed in a craft recognized as
4 an apprenticeable trade.

5 2b. The work of the apprentice in the occupations declared
6 particularly hazardous is incidental to his training.

7 3c. Such work is intermittent and for short periods of
8 time and is under the direct and close supervision of a
9 journeyman as a necessary part of such apprentice training.

10 4d. The apprentice is registered by the bureau of
11 apprenticeship and training of the United States department
12 of labor as employed in accordance with the standards
13 established by that department.

14 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
15 shall take effect and be in force from and after its
16 publication in _____, a newspaper published in
17 _____, Iowa, and in _____, a newspaper
18 published in _____, Iowa.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill is designed to correct a section of the Child
21 Labor Law passed by the 63rd General Assembly. Iowa's law
22 on school training is more restrictive than the federal
23 statute. This bill would bring Iowa's law into conformity
24 with the federal law on the same subject.
