A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate funds from the general fund of the state
2 to the higher education facilities commission for the state
3 supported scholarship and medical student tuition loan pro-
4 grams.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the higher education facilities commission
3 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be neces-
4 sary, to be used for the purposes designated:

6 Fiscal Year Fiscal Year

7 1. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM. For
8 each year of the biennium begin-
9 ning July 1, 1971, and ending
10 June 30, 1973, to finance scholar-
11 ships awarded by the commission
12 under section two hundred sixty-
13 one point two (261.2) of the
14 Code, the following amounts:

15 2. MEDICAL STUDENT TUITION LOAN PROGRAM. For each year
16 of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971 and ending June 30,
17 1973, the following amounts:

20 To finance loans to Iowa resi-
21 dent medical students under the
22 provisions of section two hun-
23 dred sixty-one point two
24 (261.2) of the Code:

25 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
26 of the higher education facilities commission are appropri-
27 ated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or
28 receipts.

29 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
30 for capital improvements.

31 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
32 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
33 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
34 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
35 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury

1 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In
 2 all other respects the provisions of section eight point
 3 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropria-
 4 tions made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Un-
 5 encumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made
 6 for the second fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject
 7 to section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

1 Amend Senate File 528 as follows:

- 2 1. Page 2, by striking lines 31 through 35, inclu-
 3 sive.
 4 2. Page 3, by striking lines 1 through 7, inclusive,
 5 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
 6 "Sec. 4. Any balance remaining in the funds for
 7 which appropriations are made by this Act at the end of
 8 the first fiscal year of the biennium shall carry forward
 9 to the second fiscal year of the biennium."
