A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to conditions of withdrawal from a county
2 library district.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Section three hundred fifty-eight B point six-
5 teen (358B.16), Code 1971, is amended as follows:

6 358B.16 WITHDRAWAL OF CITY OR TOWN FROM DISTRICT. When-
7 ever any incorporated city or town, having maintained an
8 association a library pursuant to the provisions of chapter
9 378 for at least ten years prior-to-the-establishment-of-a
10 county-library-which-has-become-a-part-of-the-tax-supported
11 city-or-town-library-and-being-a-part-of-the-county-library
12 district, and having levied a tax of its own equal-to-or
13 greater-than-that-of-the-county-library-district for the same
14 purpose, shall decide to withdraw from the county library
15 district, it may do so by giving notice by certified mail to
16 the board of library trustees of said county library and the
17 county auditor prior to July 10, by the governing body of said
18 incorporated city or town, of its withdrawal from the county
19 library district, and thereafter-said-incorporated-city-or-town,
20 shall cease to be a part of or included in said county library
21 district.

EXPLANATION

22
23 This bill eliminates the requirement that a city or town
24 must have had a library for ten years before the county library
25 was established and must have levied a tax for the city library

1 that was equal or greater than the tax levied for the county
2 library before the city may withdraw from the county library.
