1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1971 and  
3 ending June 30, 1973, for the commission on alcoholism, the  
4 following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
5 to be used in the manner designated:

12 2. For purposes of carrying

20 3. No part of the appropriation provided for the treatment  
21 of alcoholism in subsection two (2) of this section shall  
22 be used for salaries, support and maintenance of the commission  
23 on alcoholism, excluding individuals employed by local alco-  
24 holism or detoxification units. No local alcoholism or  
25 detoxification facility shall be allocated more than ten  
26 percent of the appropriation provided for the treatment of  
27 alcoholism in subsection two (2) of this section.

28 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
29 of the commission on alcoholism are appropriated for the  
30 purpose set forth in the federal grants or receipts.

31 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
32 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
33 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
34 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971  
35 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury

1 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In  
2 all other respects the provisions of section eight point  
3 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations  
4 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencum-  
5 bered or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the  
6 second fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section  
7 eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.
