A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from moneys received by certain commis-
2 sions, boards, and departments.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. For the following commissions, boards, and
 2 departments, there is appropriated all funds received under
 3 authority of the designated chapters or sections of the Code
 4 for each fiscal year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1971
 5 and ending June 30, 1973. The following amounts, or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary, are authorized to be expended
 7 from said receipts to be used for the following purposes:

9 Sec. 2. The remainder of each of the various funds referred
10 to in section one (1) of this Act is appropriated for
11 contingencies arising during the biennium which are legally
12 payable from the various funds.

13 Sec. 3. A contingency shall exclude any purpose or project
14 which was presented to the general assembly by way of a bill
15 and which failed to become enacted into law, however, for
16 the purpose of this Act an unforeseen necessity of additional
17 operating funds may be construed as a contingency.

18 Sec. 4. Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act
19 shall be allocated for contingencies it shall be determined
20 by the executive council that a contingency exists and that
21 the proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of
22 the state.

23 Sec. 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
24 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
25 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
26 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
27 shall, on September 30, 1972 revert to the state treasury
28 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In
29 all other respects the provisions of section eight point
30 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations
31 made for the first fiscal year of the biennium. Unencumbered
32 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
33 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
34 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

35 Sec. 6. Where any laws of this state are in conflict with

1 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
2 biennium.
