1 Section 1. For the following state agencies there is ap-  
 2 propriated from the general fund of the state for each fiscal  
 3 year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971 and ending June  
 4 30, 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof as is  
 5 necessary to be used in the manner designated:

32 Sec. 2. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used  
 33 for capital improvements.

34 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
 35 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or

1 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
2 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971  
3 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury  
4 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In  
5 all other respects the provisions of section eight point  
6 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropria-  
7 tions made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Un-  
8 encumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made  
9 for the second fiscal year of such biennium shall be sub-  
10 ject to section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

11 Sec. 4. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
12 of the agencies receiving funds under this Act are appro-  
13 priated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or  
14 receipts.

15 Sec. 5. Where any laws of this state are in conflict with  
16 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the  
17 biennium.
