A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of
2 Iowa to the Iowa state fair board.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state for the Iowa state fair board for each fiscal
 3 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1971 and ending June
 4 30, 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may
 5 be necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

15 The appropriations for state aid
 16 to agricultural societies shall be
 17 deemed conditional on full compli-
 18 ance with all other statutes which
 19 regulate and prescribe the condi-
 20 tions under which such aid is pay-
 21 able. In no case shall any county
 22 receive more than two thousand one
 23 hundred (2,100) dollars, except
 24 that in a county where there are
 25 two definitely separate county ex-
 26 tension offices, each such society
 27 shall receive state aid in such
 28 amount as it would be entitled to
 29 if it were the only society in the
 30 county. In counties having more
 31 than one fair entitled to state
 32 aid, the state aid available for
 33 the county shall be prorated to
 34 said fairs on the basis of cash
 35 premiums paid by said fairs.

2 Sec. 2. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
3 for capital improvements.

4 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
5 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
6 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
7 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
8 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
9 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In
10 all other respects the provisions of section eight point
11 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations
12 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
13 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
14 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
15 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

16 Sec. 4. When any of the laws of this state are in con-
17 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern
18 for the biennium.
