1 Section 1. There is created an executive council general
2 contingent fund. The fund shall be administered by the execu-
3 tive council. Allocations from the fund may be made only
4 for contingencies arising during the biennium which are le-
5 gally payable from the funds of the state. The executive
6 council shall not approve allocation of any funds for any
7 purpose or project which was presented to the general assem-
8 bly by way of a bill and which failed to become enacted into
9 law.

10 Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act shall
11 be allocated, a written recommendation shall first be ob-
12 tained from the state comptroller and the executive council
13 shall determine that the proposed allocation shall be for
14 the best interest of the state. Any allocation in excess
15 of thirty-five thousand dollars must be approved by the bud-
16 get and financial control committee.

17 Any balance in the contingent fund as of June 30, 1973,
18 shall revert to the general fund.

19 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of
20 the state for deposit in the executive council general con-
21 tingent fund for the biennium commencing July 1, 1971 and
22 ending June 30, 1973, the sum of three hundred thousand
23 (300,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
24 to be used in the manner provided in section one (1) of this
25 Act.
