## A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation from the general fund of the  
2 state to the Iowa state commerce commission and its  
3 divisions, and providing for the assessment of expenses  
4 incurred by the commission.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
 2 of the state for the Iowa state commerce commission and its  
 3 divisions for the biennium beginning July 1, 1971 and ending  
 4 June 30, 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof as  
 5 may be necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

29 Sec. 2. Section four hundred ninety A point ten (490A.10),  
 30 unnumbered paragraph two (2), Code 1971, is amended as fol-  
 31 lows:

32 The commission shall annually, within ninety days after  
 33 the close of each fiscal year, ascertain the total of its  
 34 expenditures during each year, ~~excluding the total sum nee-~~  
 35 ~~essary to pay the salaries of the commissioners but includ-~~

1 ~~ing-all-ether-expenses~~ which are reasonably attributable to  
2 the performance of its duties under this chapter and shall  
3 deduct therefrom all amounts chargeable directly to any  
4 specific utility under any law. The remainder shall be as-  
5 sessed by the commission to the several public utilities in  
6 proportion to their respective gross operating revenues dur-  
7 ing the last calendar year derived from intrastate public  
8 utility operations. The total amount which may be assessed  
9 to the public utilities under authority of this paragraph  
10 shall not exceed one-tenth of one percent of the total gross  
11 operating revenues of such public utilities during such cal-  
12 endar year derived from intrastate public utility operations.  
13 For public utilities exempted from rate regulation under this  
14 chapter, the assessments under this paragraph shall be com-  
15 puted at one-half the rate used in computing the assessment  
16 for other utilities.

17 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
18 of the Iowa state commerce commission and its divisions are  
19 appropriated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants  
20 or receipts.

21 Sec. 4. No funds appropriated by this Act shall be used  
22 for capital improvements.

23 Sec. 5. When any provision of the laws of this state are  
24 in conflict with this Act in designating certain funds to  
25 be used for certain purposes, the provisions of this Act shall  
26 govern for the biennium.

27 Sec. 6. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
28 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
29 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
30 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971  
31 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury  
32 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In  
33 all other respects the provisions of section eight point  
34 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations  
35 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered

1 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second  
2 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight  
3 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

1 Amend Senate File 558, page 3, line 32, by inserting  
2 the following after the period:  
3 "The Iowa state commerce commission may make applica-  
4 tion to the committees on appropriations for the reap-  
5 portionment of any funds that do revert, or probably  
6 will revert upon the dates herein set and the respective  
7 committees on appropriations or a subcommittee thereof  
8 shall hold a hearing upon the application while the  
9 general assembly is in regular session."
