A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate and authorize expenditures from the
2 car dispatcher revolving fund.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated, and the state car
2 dispatcher is authorized to expend, from the car dispatcher
3 revolving fund established under section twenty-one point
4 six (21.6) of the Code, for each fiscal year of the bien-
5 nium commencing July 1, 1971 and ending June 30, 1973, the
6 following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
7 to be used in the manner designated:

13 Sec. 2. The remainder of the fund is appropriated for
14 the purchase of gasoline, oil, tires, repairs and all other
15 maintenance expenses incurred in the operation of state owned
16 motor vehicles and contingencies arising during the biennium
17 which are legally payable from this fund. For the purpose
18 of this Act a necessity of additional operating funds under
19 section one (1) of this Act may be construed as a contingency.

20 Sec. 3. Before any of the funds appropriated by this Act
21 shall be allocated for contingencies it shall be determined
22 by the executive council that a contingency exists and that
23 the proposed allocation shall be for the best interest of
24 the state.

25 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
26 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
27 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
28 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
29 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
30 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In
31 all other respects the provisions of section eight point
32 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations
33 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
34 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
35 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight

1 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

2 Sec. 5. When any laws of this state are in conflict with
3 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
4 biennium.

4 the committees on appropriations for the reapportionment
5 of any funds that do revert, or probably will revert
6 upon the dates herein set and the respective committees

8 a hearing upon the application while the general assembly
9 is in regular session."
