A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state of
2 Iowa to the state historical society for development of
3 designated historical sites.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the biennium beginning July 1, 1971, and
3 ending June 30, 1973, to the state historical society the
4 sum of twelve thousand (12,000) dollars, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, to be used for further development of
6 Toolsboro Mounds and museum area, and the sum of eight thousand
7 (8,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to
8 be used for further development and maintenance of Gardner
9 Log Cabin.

10 Sec. 2. The state historical society, the governor, and
11 the state comptroller are authorized to obtain and accept
12 federal grants to the state to be used in connection with
13 the funds appropriated in this Act.

14 Sec. 3. Any unencumbered balance remaining as of June
15 30, 1973, of the appropriation of this Act shall revert to
16 the general fund of the state as of June 30, 1973.
