1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the state historical society for each fiscal
3 year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971 and ending June
4 30, 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

11 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
12 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
13 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
14 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
15 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
16 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In
17 all other respects the provisions of section eight point
18 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations
19 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
20 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
21 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
22 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

23 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
24 for capital improvements.

25 Sec. 4. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict
26 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for
27 the biennium.
