1 An Act making an appropriation from the primary road fund to

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the primary road
2 fund to the industrial commission for each year of the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 1971 and ending June 30, 1973 the following
4 amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used
5 in the manner designated:

15 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
16 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
17 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
18 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
19 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
20 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. The
21 industrial commission may make application to the committees
22 on appropriations for the reappropriation of any funds that
23 do revert, or probably will revert upon the dates herein set
24 and the respective committees on appropriations or a sub-
25 committee thereof shall hold a hearing upon such application
26 while the general assembly is in regular session. In all
27 other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-
28 three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made
29 for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
30 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
31 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
32 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

33 Sec. 3. When any provision of the laws of this state are
34 in conflict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall
35 govern for the biennium.
