A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state for
2 the Iowa commission for the blind.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state to the Iowa commission for the blind for each
 3 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1971 and ending June
 4 30, 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may
 5 be necessary, to be used for the following purposes:

16 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
 17 of the commission are appropriated for the purpose set forth
 18 in such federal grants or receipts.

19 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
 20 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
 21 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
 22 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
 23 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
 24 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. The
 25 Iowa commission for the blind may make application to the
 26 committees on appropriations for the reappropriation of any
 27 funds that do revert, or probably will revert upon the dates
 28 herein set and the respective committees on appropriations
 29 or a subcommittee thereof shall hold a hearing upon such
 30 application while the general assembly is in regular session.
 31 In all other respects the provisions of section eight point
 32 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations
 33 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
 34

1 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
2 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
3 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

4 Sec. 4. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict
5 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for
6 the biennium.
