1 An Act to make an appropriation to the department of public

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state to the department of public instruction for each
 3 year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1971 and ending June
 4 30, 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may
 5 be necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

22 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
 23 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
 24 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
 25 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
 26 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
 27 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. In
 28 all other respects the provisions of section eight point
 29 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations
 30 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
 31 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
 32 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
 33 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

34 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
 35 of these departments and divisions thereof are hereby appro-

1 oriated for the purpose set forth in such federal grants or
2 receipts.

3 Sec. 4. No moneys appropriated in this Act shall be used
4 for capital improvements.

5 Sec. 5. When any laws of this state are in conflict with
6 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
7 biennium.

1 Amend Senate File 577 as follows:
2 Page 4, line 35, by adding after the period the following:
3 "The department of public instruction may make application
4 to the committees on appropriations for the reappropriation of
5 any funds that do revert, or probably will revert upon the dates
6 herein set and the respective committees on appropriations or a
7 subcommittee thereof shall hold a hearing upon the application
8 while the general assembly is in regular session."
