1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state to the Iowa development commission for each year
 3 of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971 and ending June 30,
 4 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be
 5 necessary, to be used in the manner designated:

12 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
 13 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
 14 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
 15 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
 16 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
 17 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. The
 18 Iowa development commission may make application to the
 19 committees on appropriations for the reapportionment of any
 20 funds that do revert, or probably will revert upon the dates
 21 herein set and the respective committees on appropriations
 22 or a subcommittee thereof shall hold a hearing upon such
 23 application while the general assembly is in regular session.
 24 In all other respects the provisions of section eight point
 25 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations
 26 made for the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered
 27 or unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
 28 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
 29 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

30 Sec. 3. When any provisions of the laws of this state
 31 are in conflict with this Act, the provisions of this Act
 32 shall govern for the biennium.

33 Sec. 4. No funds appropriated by this Act shall be used
 34 for capital improvements.
