A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation to the supreme court and dis-
2 trict courts.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state to the Iowa supreme court and Iowa district
 3 courts for each fiscal year of the biennium commencing July
 4 1, 1971 and ending June 30, 1973, the following amounts, or
 5 so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used in the man-
 6 ner designated:

10 a. For the salaries of
 11 the judges of the district
 12 courts of Iowa, and a state
 13 contribution to the judicial
 14 retirement system provided

 16 five A (605A) of the Code,
 17 in the amount of three per-
 18 cent of such salaries and
 19 an additional contribution
 20 of fifty-nine thousand
 21 (59,000) dollars for each
 22 year of the biennium:

 34 judges of the supreme court
 35 of Iowa and a state contri-

1 bution to the judicial re-
 2 tirement system provided for
 3 in chapter six hundred five
 4 A (605A) of the Code in the
 5 amount of three percent of
 6 such salaries and an addi-
 7 tional state contribution
 8 of forty-six thousand six
 9 hundred (46,600) dollars
 10 for each year of the bien-
 11 nium, and for other salaries,
 12 support, maintenance and
 13 miscellaneous purposes, in-
 14 cluding one thousand (1,000)
 15 dollars for the cost of ju-
 16 dicial conferences as pro-
 17 vided in section six hundred
 18 eighty-four point twenty
 19 (684.20) of the Code, pur-
 20 suant to the provisions of
 21 section six hundred one
 22 point one hundred thirty-
 23 four (601.134) of the Code: \$ 453,750.00 \$ 453,260.00
 24 b. For rules of pro-
 25 cedure: \$ 250.00 \$ 250.00
 26 Total: \$ 454,000.00 \$ 453,510.00

27 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
 28 of the courts receiving funds under this Act are appropri-
 29 ated for the purpose set forth in the federal grants or
 30 receipts.

31 Sec. 3. No moneys appropriated by this Act shall be used
 32 for capital improvements.

33 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
 34 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
 35 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for

1 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
2 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
3 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. The
4 courts receiving funds under this Act may make application
5 to the committees on appropriations for the reappropriation
6 of any funds that do revert, or probably will revert upon
7 the dates herein set and the respective committees on appro-
8 priations or a subcommittee thereof shall hold a hearing upon
9 the application while the general assembly is in regular ses-
10 sion. In all other respects the provisions of section eight
11 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appro-
12 priations made for the first fiscal year of such biennium.
13 Unencumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made
14 for the second fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject
15 to section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

16 Sec. 5. When any of the laws of this state are in con-
17 flict with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern
18 for the biennium.
