1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
 2 of the state to the department of public instruction for each
 3 fiscal year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1971 and ending
 4 June 30, 1973, the following amounts, or so much thereof as
 5 may be necessary, to be used for the purpose designated:

18 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twenty-one point one hun-
 19 dred seventy-eight (321.178), subsection one (1), unnumbered
 20 paragraph two (2), Code 1971, is amended as follows:

21 Commencing with the September, 1965, school term, the state
 22 shall reimburse each public school district in an amount not
 23 to exceed thirty dollars per student for each student complet-
 24 ing an approved driver education course offered or made avail-
 25 able by the school district. Every public school district
 26 in Iowa shall offer or make available to all students residing
 27 in the school district an approved course in driver education.
 28 An approved course offered during the summer months, on Satur-
 29 days, after regular school hours during the regular terms
 30 or partly in one term or summer vacation period and partly
 31 in the succeeding term or summer vacation period, as the case
 32 may be, shall satisfy the requirements of this section to
 33 the same extent as an approved course offered during the regu-
 34 lar school hours of the school term. Funds for such reimburse-
 35 ment shall be appropriated by the legislature to a special

1 driver education fund to be administered by the department
2 of public instruction. ~~Two~~ Four percent of the annual amount
3 allocated to the special driver education fund, shall be
4 available to the department of public instruction for use
5 in discharging the cost of administration of this section.

6 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
7 of the department in relation to this Act are appropriated
8 for the purpose set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

9 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
10 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
11 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
12 the first fiscal year of the biennium commencing July 1, 1971
13 shall, on September 30, 1972, revert to the state treasury
14 and to the credit of the fund from which appropriated. The
15 department may make application to the committees on ap-
16 propriations for the reappropriation of any funds that do
17 revert, or probably will revert upon the dates herein set
18 and the respective committees on appropriations or a subcom-
19 mittee thereof shall hold a hearing upon the application while
20 the general assembly is in regular session. In all other
21 respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-three
22 (8.33) of the Code shall apply to appropriations made for
23 the first fiscal year of such biennium. Unencumbered or
24 unobligated balances of appropriations made for the second
25 fiscal year of such biennium shall be subject to section eight
26 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code.

27 Sec. 5. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict
28 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for
29 the biennium.
