A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate funds from the general fund of the state
2 of Iowa to the state board of regents to reimburse state
3 educational institutions for deficiencies in operating
4 revenues resulting from funds pledged to finance academic
5 and administrative buildings and facilities and utilities
6 services.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the state board of regents for the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 1971 and ending June 30, 1973, the sum of
4 three million one hundred fifty-one thousand (3,151,000)
5 dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be allo-
6 cated by said board to the state university of Iowa, the
7 Iowa state university of science and technology, and the
8 university of northern Iowa in such amounts as may be neces-
9 sary to reimburse such institutions for deficiencies in their
10 operating funds resulting from the pledging of tuitions,
11 student fees and charges and institutional income to finance
12 the cost of providing academic and administrative buildings
13 and facilities and utilities services at said institutions
14 of higher learning.

15 Sec. 2. When any laws of this state are in conflict with
16 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
17 biennium.

18 Sec. 3. Any balance remaining in the funds to which
19 appropriations are made by this Act, at the end of the first
20 fiscal year of the biennium shall carry forward to the
21 beginning of the second fiscal year of the biennium.

22 Sec. 4. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
23 of the state board of regents are hereby appropriated for
24 the purpose set forth in such federal grants or receipts.
