1 Section 1. Section ninety-six point five (96.5), subsection
2 five (5), Code 1971, is amended as follows:

3 5. OTHER COMPENSATION. For any week with respect to which
4 he is receiving, has received, or is entitled to receive pay-
5 ment in the form of:

6 a. Wages in lieu of notice;

7 b. Compensation for temporary disability under the work-
8 men's compensation law of any state or under a similar law of
9 the United States;

10 c. Old-age benefits under title II of the Social Security
11 Act (42 USC, chapter 7), as amended, or similar retirement pay-
12 ments under any Act of Congress; provided that the commission
13 shall withhold payments under this chapter if it has reason to
14 believe a claimant is entitled to benefits under title II of
15 the Social Security Act of the United States or any similar
16 payments under any other Act of Congress, until such time as
17 the claimant files with the commission satisfactory evidence
18 that he is not entitled to such benefits;

19 d. Benefits paid as retirement pay or as private pension.

20 Provided, that if such remuneration is less than the benefits
21 which would otherwise be due under this chapter, he shall be
22 entitled to receive for such week, if otherwise eligible, bene-
23 fits reduced by the amount of such remuneration. Provided
24 further, if benefits were paid for any week under this chapter
25 for a period when benefits, remuneration or compensation under
26 paragraphs "a", "b", "c", or "d", of this subsection were paid
27 on a retroactive basis for the same period, or any part thereof,
28 the commission shall recover any such excess amount of benefits
29 paid by the commission for such period, and no employer's
30 account shall be charged with benefits so paid, provided
31 further, however, that retirement pay or compensation for service-
32 connected disabilities or pensions and compensation for accrued
33 leave based on military service, by the beneficiary, with the
34 armed forces of the United States, irrespective of the amount of
35 the benefit, shall in no way disqualify any individual, other-
