## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to temporary registration of snowmobiles.  
2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one G point one  
2 (321G.1), Code 1971, is amended by adding the following new  
3 subsection:

4 "'Dealer' means any person engaged in the business of buying,  
5 selling, or exchanging snowmobiles required to be registered  
6 who has an established place of business in this state."

7 Sec. 2. Chapter three hundred twenty-one G (321G), Code  
8 1971, is amended by adding the following new section:

9 "The state conservation commission shall furnish snowmobile  
10 dealers with pasteboard cards bearing the words 'registration  
11 applied for'. Any unregistered snowmobile sold by a dealer  
12 shall bear one of these cards which shall entitle the purchaser  
13 to operate it for ten days immediately following the purchase.  
14 The purchaser of a registered snowmobile shall be entitled to  
15 operate it for ten days immediately following the purchase,  
16 without having completed a transfer of registration. Any per-  
17 son who purchases a snowmobile from a dealer shall, within five  
18 days of the purchase, apply for a snowmobile registration or  
19 transfer of registration."

EXPLANATION

21 This bill provides for temporary operation of snowmobiles  
22 by purchasers prior to actual registration or transfer of  
23 registration.
