## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Joint Resolution establishing legislative compensation to  
2 be paid because of a vacancy resulting in the Senate  
3 membership.

4 WHEREAS, a vacancy was created in the eleventh district  
5 due to the death of Senator Charles K. Sullivan; and

6 WHEREAS, this vacancy was filled by the election of  
7 Senator G. William Gross at a special election held on  
8 March 8, 1971; and

9 WHEREAS, some question has arisen with reference to the  
10 language in section two point ten (2.10), subsection four (4)  
11 of the Code, regarding proportional compensation when a  
12 vacancy occurs because it appears that such subsection  
13 anticipates that legislative salaries be paid over a twelve  
14 month period rather than a six month period as provided in sub-  
15 section five (5) of section two point ten (2.10) of the Code; and

16 WHEREAS, the proceedings for computing the proportional  
17 compensation of a member of the General Assembly are vague  
18 and subject to ambiguity and Article three (III), section  
19 nine (9), of the Constitution of the State of Iowa grants to  
20 each house of the General Assembly the power to determine its  
21 rules and proceedings, NOW THEREFORE,

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF  
23 IOWA:

24 Section 1. Senator Charles K. Sullivan or his surviving  
25 spouse shall be paid a total of \$1,374.99 in salary for the

1 calendar year 1971, and Senator G. William Gross be paid a  
2 total of \$4,583.34 in salary for the calendar year 1971.

3 EXPLANATION

4 This bill establishes the manner of apportioning  
5 legislative salaries between Senator Charles K. Sullivan,  
6 deceased, and his successor, Senator G. William Gross.
