A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the appropriation for the construction of a
2 state office building.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1973
2 Session, chapter ninety-seven (97), section one (1), subsec-
3 tion three (3), is amended to read as follows:

4 3. For the department of general services for the financing
5 and construction of a state office building in accordance
6 with the plans developed under the provisions of this Act
7 . . \$~~5,000,000~~ 12,500,000.

8 Sec. 2. Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1973
9 Session, chapter ninety-seven (97), section eight (8), is
10 amended to read as follows:

11 Sec. 8. Any unobligated balance of funds as of June 30,
12 ~~1974~~ 1975 appropriated by subsections one (1) and two (2)
13 of section one (1) of this Act shall revert to the credit
14 of the general fund on August 31, ~~1974~~ 1975. ~~Unobligated~~
15 ~~or-unexpended-funds-appropriated-by-subsection-three-(3)-of~~
16 ~~section-one-(1)-of-this-Act-shall-not-revert-to-the-credit~~

19 funds appropriated by subsections one (1) and two (2) of

21 per diem and expenses of members of the capitol planning
22 commission for time expended in carrying out their duties
23 as provided in this Act.

24 EXPLANATION

25 The capitol planning commission has completed the
26 preliminary plans for the construction of the state office
27 building. The commission has determined that it will take
28 the sum of \$12,500,000 to construct the state office building
29 pursuant to such plans. This bill changes the original
30 appropriation for the construction of the state office building
31 from \$5,000,000 to \$12,500,000. Planning will continue for
32 both the state office building and an agricultural building
33 The time involved in previous planning by the capitol planning
34 commission greatly exceeded the time involved in normal duties
35 of the commission, and this bill allows for payment of per

1 diem and expenses from planning funds for time spent in making
2 the plans for the state office building and agricultural
3 building since the commission's normal appropriation for per
4 diem and expenses is not sufficient because of the planning
5 functions involved with these two buildings. The use of such
6 planning funds has also been extended an additional year.
7 Another bill provides for the appropriation of funds sufficient
8 to construct a state agricultural building.
