A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation to the capitol planning com-
2 mission for the planning of a central mall.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state one hundred thousand (100,000) dollars, or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary, to be used by the capitol
4 planning commission and in the manner designated for expenses
5 incurred, including fees for architectural services, in the
6 planning of a capitol mall at the seat of government.

7 Sec. 2. Plans for the construction of the capitol mall
8 shall provide for a central cafeteria, underground parking
9 for two hundred fifty cars, peripheral parking, heating plant,
10 meeting rooms and central supply area. The director of the
11 department of general services shall cooperate with the capitol
12 planning commission in the preparation of the plans for the
13 capitol mall. The capitol planning commission shall make
14 periodic reports to the legislative council regarding the
15 development of plans for the capitol mall.

16 Sec. 3. The governor, the director of the department of
17 general services, the capitol planning commission, or the
18 state comptroller are authorized to obtain and accept fed-
19 eral funds available for use in carrying out the project
20 authorized by this Act.

21 Sec. 4. The capitol planning commission and the depart-
22 ment of general services may employ technical assistants in
23 order to carry out the provisions of this Act.

24 Sec. 5. Any unobligated balance of funds as of June 30,
25 1975, appropriated by section one (1) of this Act shall re-
26 vert to the credit of the general fund on August 31, 1975.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill provides for an appropriation for the planning
29 of a capitol mall.
