A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to escort vehicles.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

3 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one E point nine
4 (321E.9), subsection three (3), Code 1973, is amended to
5 read as follows:

6 3. Vehicles with indivisible loads having an ~~over-all~~
7 overall width not to exceed twelve feet, zero inches, an
8 ~~ever-all~~ overall length not to exceed eighty feet, zero inches,
9 and total gross weight not to exceed ninety thousand pounds
10 may be moved for unlimited distances over specified routes
11 when and, when the same is required by the issuing authority,
12 shall be accompanied by a civilian escort approved by the
13 issuing authority. The height of such vehicle and load shall
14 be limited only to the height limitations of underpasses,
15 bridges, power lines, and other established height restrictions
16 on the specified route. An official escort may be provided
17 for such movement at the option of the permit holder.

EXPLANATION

19 This bill makes the requirement of an escort vehicle a
20 discretionary matter with the state highway commission.

20 speed of fifty miles per hour, the time of escort-
21 ing the load, and the return of the escort from
22 the destination of the load to the escort's
23 residence at an average speed of fifty miles per
24 hour. Proration of escort fees between state and
25 local authorities when more than one governmental

1 authority provides or is required to provide escort
2 for a movement during the period of a day shall be
3 determined by rule under section 321E.15. The
4 commission and local authorities may charge any
5 permit applicant for the cost of trimming trees
6 and removal and replacement of natural obstructions
7 or official signs and signals or other public or
8 private property required to be removed during the
9 movement of a vehicle and load.
