- 2 page 2, line 8, by inserting after the period the
- 3 following: "Such attorney shall be an assistant
- 4 attorney general appointed by the attorney general
- 5 who shall fix his salary. The department shall
- 6 reimburse the attorney general for the salary and
- 7 expense of such assistant attorney general and
- 8 furnish him a suitable office if requested by the
- 9 attorney general."

1 Section 1. Section eighty point one (80.1), Code 1973,
2 is amended to read as follows:

3 80.1 DEPARTMENT CREATED. There is hereby created a de-
4 partment of the state government which shall be known and
5 designated as the department of public safety, which shall
6 consist of a commissioner of public safety and of such of-
7 ficers and employees as may be required, one of whom shall
8 be an attorney admitted to practice law in this state.

9 Sec. 2. Section eighty point twenty-five (80.25), Code
10 1973, is amended to read as follows:

11 80.25 DIVISION OF BEER AND LIQUOR ENFORCEMENT. The com-
12 missioner of public safety shall establish a division of beer
13 and liquor law enforcement and appoint a chief enforcement of-
14 ficer to head the division, ~~who shall be an attorney licensed~~
15 ~~to practice in this state, and the.~~ The commissioner of pub-
16 lic safety shall appoint other agents needed in the division
17 as are necessary to enforce the provisions of Title VI of the
18 Code. All enforcement officers, assistants, and agents of
19 the division, excluding clerical workers, shall be subject
20 to the provisions of section 80.15.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill deletes the statutory requirement that the chief
23 of the beer and liquor enforcement division be an attorney,
24 and substitutes the general requirement that there be an
25 attorney in the Department.
