1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1974 and
3 ending June 30, 1975, to the division of public buildings
4 and grounds of the department of general services the sum
5 of five hundred thousand (500,000) dollars, or so much there-
6 of as may be necessary, to be used for restoring and recon-
7 structing the exterior masonry and the exterior steps of
8 the state capitol building.

9 Sec. 2. Before any funds appropriated by this Act are
10 expended, it shall be determined by the director of general
11 services that the expenditure is for the best interest of
12 the state.

13 Sec. 3. Any unencumbered balance of funds appropriated
14 by this Act remaining as of June 30, 1975, shall revert to
15 the general fund of the state on September 30, 1975.

16 Sec. 4. It is the intent of the general assembly that
17 funds appropriated pursuant to this Act shall be used to
18 restore and reconstruct the exterior of the capitol build-
19 ing to complete all phases of such project including archi-
20 tect fees and including, but not necessarily limited to,
21 tuckpointing, caulking, waterproofing, painting, limited
22 sandblasting, repair of cornices, and reconstruction of steps
23 on all sides of the state capitol building. Worn sandstone
24 entrances are to be replaced with granite. This appropri-
25 ation also allows for the salary of one inspector to super-
26 vise this project.

27 Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
28 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publi-
29 cation in the Bettendorf News, a newspaper published in
30 Bettendorf, Iowa, and in The Logan Herald-Observer, a news-
31 paper published in Logan, Iowa.

32 EXPLANATION

33 This bill makes an appropriation from the general fund
34 to the department of general services for capital improve-
35 ments to the capitol building.
