A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to class "A" liquor control licenses of
2 clubs which are branches of chartered veterans organi-
3 zations.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

5 Section 1. Section one hundred twenty-three point thirty-
6 six (123.36), subsection two (2), Code 1973, is amended to
7 read as follows:

8 2. Class "A" liquor control licenses, the sum of six
9 hundred dollars, except that for class "A" licenses in towns
10 of less than two thousand population, and for clubs of less
11 than two hundred fifty members, the license fee shall be
12 four hundred dollars; however, the fee shall be two hundred
13 dollars for any club which is a post, branch, or chapter of
14 a veterans organization chartered by the Congress of the
15 United States, if such club does not sell or permit the con-
16 sumption of alcoholic beverages or beer on the premises more
17 than one day in any week, and if the application for a license
18 states that such club does not and will not sell or permit
19 the consumption of alcoholic beverages or beer on the
20 premises more than one day in any week.

EXPLANATION

22 This bill is corrective in nature in that beer was intended
23 to be treated in the same manner as alcoholic beverages to
24 fulfill the requirements for the reduced liquor control license
25 fee for veterans organization clubs.
