1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1974 and
3 ending June 30, 1975, to the department of agriculture, the
4 following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
5 to be used for the following purposes:

6 1. AGRICULTURE MARKETING DIVISION

7 For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous
8 purposes:

- 9 a. Livestock auction market reporting \$ 30,750
- 10 b. Grain market reporting 21,253
- 11 c. Other marketing division programs 129,700

12 Sec. 2. Moneys appropriated by this Act shall not be used
13 for capital improvements.

14 Sec. 3. When any of the laws of this state are in conflict
15 with this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
16 fiscal year.

17 Sec. 4. The intent of the general assembly in making this
18 appropriation is to continue the present programs of the
19 marketing division with an expansion of the livestock auction
20 market reporting service and the start of a grain market re-
21 porting service. It is the intent of the general assembly
22 that the agriculture promotion effort be maintained at the
23 present level.

24 Sec. 5. Unencumbered funds as of June 30, 1975 shall re-
25 vert to the general fund of the state as of September 30, 1975.
