1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1974 and
3 ending June 30, 1975, to the Iowa development commission,
4 the following amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
5 to be used in the manner designated:

- 6 1. For the commission's per
- 7 diem allowance \$ 7,500
- 8 2. For the regional tourism
- 9 districts 30,000
- 10 3. For the agriculture
- 11 products promotion programs 163,300

12 Sec. 2. From funds appropriated by section one (!), sub-
13 section two (2) of this Act the Iowa development commission
14 shall allocate the funds to the regional tourism districts
15 only if the district which will receive the funds provides
16 on a dollar-to-dollar matching basis funds equal to the
17 amount allocated by the Iowa development commission.

18 Sec. 3. Unencumbered funds as of June 30, 1975 shall
19 revert to the general fund of the state as of September 30,
20 1975.

21 Sec. 4. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
22 of the agency receiving funds under this Act are appropriated
23 for the purpose set forth in such grants or receipts.

24 Sec. 5. Funds appropriated by this Act shall not be used
25 for capital improvements.

26 Sec. 6. The intent of the general assembly in making
27 this appropriation is to fund the special promotions as re-
28 quested by the Iowa development commission. The project
29 development items are funded by the priorities established
30 pursuant to the Iowa development commission budget request
31 document, except that items eight, ten, eleven, and twelve
32 of the document are not funded. It is also the intent of
33 the general assembly that the export promotion program is
34 not funded by this Act.
