3 Sec. 2. It is the intent of the general assembly that the
4 funds appropriated under this Act shall be used for the fol-
5 lowing purposes:

6 1. The supplemental support appropriations for planning
7 and development are to purchase additional contract planning
8 and design services. These funds will enable the state high-
9 way commission to maintain its present production schedule
10 for construction projects currently funded in the present
11 five-year program.

12 2. The supplemental support appropriations for field
13 operation is to offset the inflationary effect for increased
14 cost of materials and supplies.

15 Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
16 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-
17 tion in The Toledo Chronicle, a newspaper published in
18 Tama, Iowa, and in the Cedar Valley Times, a
19 newspaper published in Vinton, Iowa.

4 Sec. _____. Section three hundred six C point eleven
5 (306C.11), subsection five (5), Code 1973, as amended
6 by Acts of the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1973
7 Session, chapter two hundred one (201), section two
8 (2), is amended to read as follows:

9 5. Signs, displays, and devices giving specific
10 information of interest to the traveling public, shall
11 be erected by the commission and maintained within
12 the right of way in such areas, and at appropriate
13 distances from interchanges on the interstate system
14 and freeway primary highways as shall conform with
15 the rules promulgated by the commission. Such rules
16 shall be consistent with national standards promulgated
17 from time to time by the appropriate authority of the
18 federal government pursuant to Title 23, section 131,
19 paragraph "f" of the United States Code, except as
20 provided in this section. For purposes of this divi-
21 sion, "specific information of interest to the travel-
22 ing public" means only information about public places
23 for outdoor recreation, camping, lodging, eating, and
24 gas motor fuel and associated services which means the
25 business shall be in continuous operation sixteen hours
26 per day, seven days per week, with telephones and
27 restroom facilities, motor fuel, oil, and water,
28 including trade names.

29 Sec. _____. Section three hundred six C point eleven
30 (306C.11), unnumbered paragraph two (2), Code 1973,
31 is amended to read as follows:

32 Commercial vendors using informational signs shall
33 furnish and maintain informational panels to the com-
34 mission and the commercial vendor shall pay an annual
35 fee of twenty-five dollars for each informational
36 panel to the commission for posting such informational
37 panels. Upon furnishing the informational panels to
38 the commission and payment of the annual twenty-five
39 dollar fee, the commission shall post the informational
40 panels and the commercial vendor shall not be required
41 to remove any advertising device, except any advertis-
42 ing device which a court has ruled was unlawfully
43 erected in violation of sections three hundred six C
44 point eleven (306C.11) or three hundred six C point
45 thirteen (306C.13) of the Code, as a condition
46 precedent to the posting of such informational panels
47 by the commission. There is created in the office of
48 the treasurer of state a fund to be known as the
49 "highway beautification fund" and all funds received
