- 1 1. Amend House File 1468, page 3, by inserting
- 2 after line 14 the following new section:
- 3 Sec. _____. Section two hundred eighteen point one
- 4 (218.1), Code 1973, is amended by adding the
- 5 following new unnumbered paragraph:
- 6 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. Neither the
- 7 commissioner nor any other officer of the department
- 8 shall close or discontinue the operation of any of
- 9 the institutions named in subsections one (1)
- 10 through sixteen (16) of this section unless the
- 11 closing or discontinuation is specifically
- 12 authorized by law.
- 13 2. By renumbering the remaining section.

1 Section 1. 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal biennium beginning July 1, 1973
3 and ending June 30, 1975 to the department of social services,
4 the following amounts, or so much thereof as may be neces-
5 sary, to be used in the manner designated.

8 a. To the department of
9 social services for increased
10 food and fuel costs to be
11 allocated by the commissioner
12 of social services to the
13 various institutions under
14 the jurisdiction of the de-
15 partment of social services. \$800,000 \$1,000,000

16 b. To the department of
17 social services for mandatory
18 presentence investigation. \$ 200,000

19 2. The appropriations made to the department of social
20 services by this section are in addition to those provided
21 by the Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1973 Session.

22 Sec. 2. The commissioner of social services may, with
23 the approval of the executive council, grant easement rights
24 to the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company for the purpose
25 of installing and maintaining telephone lines over or under
26 a portion of the training school for boys in Eldora, Iowa.

27 Sec. 3. Unencumbered funds as of June 30, 1974 of the
28 funds appropriated by this Act for the fiscal year beginning
29 July 1, 1973 shall revert to the general fund of the state
30 on August 31, 1974. Unencumbered funds as of June 30, 1975
31 of the funds appropriated for the fiscal year beginning
32 July 1, 1974 shall revert to the general fund of the state
33 on September 30, 1975. Funds appropriated by this Act shall
34 not be used for capital improvements.

35 Sec. 4. It is the intent of the general assembly that

1 funds appropriated pursuant to paragraph a of subsection one
2 (1) of section one (1) of this Act are to be used to supple-
3 ment the support and maintenance portion of the budgets of
4 the institutions under the control of the department of social
5 services which budgets appear to be inadequate because of
6 increased food and fuel costs resulting from inflation. It
7 is also the intent of the general assembly in making the ap-
8 propriation pursuant to paragraph b of subsection one (1)
9 of section one (1) of this Act to provide funds to employ
10 additional personnel, to pay for their support and maintenance
11 in carrying out the provisions of the Acts of the Sixty-fifth
12 General Assembly, 1973 Session, chapter two hundred ninety-
13 five (295), which requires mandatory presentence investiga-
14 tion commencing July 1, 1974.

15 Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
16 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-
17 tion in the Times-Democrat, a newspaper published in
18 Davenport, Iowa, and The Boone News-Republican, a
19 newspaper published in Boone, Iowa.
