A BILL FOR

1 An Act to appropriate funds from the general fund of the state
2 to the department of environmental quality for the purpose
3 of monitoring levels of sulfur oxide emissions from power
4 generating plants.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the
2 state to the department of environmental quality for the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 1973 and ending June 30, 1975, the sum of one
4 hundred thirty-three thousand (133,000) dollars, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, to provide for the monitoring of sulfur oxide
6 emissions from power generating plants.

7 Sec. 2. It is the intent of the general assembly that the
8 appropriation made in section one (1) of this Act shall be used
9 for the purchase of sulfur oxide monitoring equipment and to
10 pay the salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous
11 expenses of monitoring power generating plants for sulfur oxide
12 emissions.

13 Sec. 3. Unencumbered funds as of June 30, 1975 appropriated
14 by this Act shall revert to the general fund of the state on
15 September 30, 1975.

16 Sec. 4. When any laws of this state are in conflict with
17 this Act, the provisions of this Act shall govern for the
18 biennium.

19 Sec. 5. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
20 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication
21 in The Red Oak Express, a newspaper published in Red Oak,
22 Iowa, and in the Hampton Chronicle, a newspaper published in
23 Hampton, Iowa.
