A BILL FOR

1 An Act to make appropriations from the general fund of the state
2 to certain persons in the settlement of claims made against the
3 state of Iowa.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of
6 the state to the following persons the amount set opposite their
7 respective names in full settlement of all claims which they may
8 have against the state of Iowa:

1 Amend House File 1487 as follows:

2 1. Page 1, line 6, by inserting after the word
3 "state" the words ", reimbursement fund, and the road
4 use tax fund".

5 2. Page 4, by inserting after line 2 the follow-
6 ing:

7 Sec. _____. The amount of the claims against the
8 state in subsections eight (8), twelve (12), eighteen
9 (18) and twenty-eight (28) of section one (1) of this
10 Act shall be paid from the reimbursement fund provided
11 for in section three hundred twenty-one point one
12 hundred twenty-nine (321.129) of the Code and the
13 amount of the claim in subsection twenty-one (21)
14 of section one (1) of this Act shall be paid from
15 the road use tax fund. The remainder of the claims
16 listed in section one (1) of this Act shall be paid
17 from the general fund of the state.

18 3. Amend the title on page 1, line 1, by insert-
19 ing after the word "state" the words ", reimbursement
20 fund, and the road use tax fund".

21 4. By numbering the section to conform with this
22 amendment.
