A BILL FOR

1 An Act appropriating from the general fund of the state to
2 the department of public instruction for distribution
3 to the merged area schools for salary adjustments and
4 equipment replacement.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the department of public instruction for the
3 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1974, and ending June 30, 1975,
4 the following amounts or so much thereof as may be necessary,
5 to be used for the following designated purposes:

6 1. To provide for a six point five per-
7 cent average increase in salaries for all
8 merged area school personnel except per-
9 sonnel whose positions are one hundred
10 percent funded by federal sources. To the
11 extent necessary to provide salary increases,
12 this subsection supersedes Acts of the
13 Sixty-fifth General Assembly, 1973 Session,
14 chapter one hundred ten (110), section five
15 (5), unnumbered paragraph two (2). However,
16 salaries for area school superintendents
17 shall not be increased beyond the limits
18 provided in section two hundred eighty A
19 point twenty-three (280A.23), subsection
20 nine (9), of the Code as amended \$2,250,000

21 2. To provide for equipment replace-
22 ment in all merged area schools on a
23 basis consistent with past allocations
24 made from equipment inventory listings \$ 250,000

25 Sec. 2. Unencumbered funds appropriated by this Act as
26 of June 30, 1975 shall revert to the general fund of the state
27 on September 30, 1975.

28 Sec. 3. The funds available under the provisions of this
29 Act shall be for merged area school personnel salary
30 adjustments and equipment replacement at the merged area
31 schools. The department of public instruction shall require
32 all merged area schools to submit current salary budgets for
33 the purposes provided in subsection one (1) of section one
34 (1) of this Act for certification and allocation of funds
35 provided for in this Act. Any funds remaining following the

1 multiplication of six point five percent times the total
2 budgeted salaries certified by the department of public
3 instruction may be added to the equipment replacement funds
4 provided in this Act before distribution to the merged area
5 schools.
