## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the fees of jurors.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
- 3 Section 1. Section six hundred seven point five (607.5),
- 4 Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 607.5 FEES OF JURORS. Petit jurors shall receive the
- 6 following fees: For each day's service or attendance in
- 7 courts of record, including jurors summoned on special venire,
- 8 five ten dollars, and for each mile traveled from his resi-
- 9 dence to the place of trial for each day's service and atten-
- 10 dance, ten cents.
- 11 Grand jurors shall receive for each day's service or atten-
- 12 dance, seven twelve dollars, and for each mile traveled each
- 13 day from his residence to the place of attendance and in the
- 14 performance of their duties, seven cents, provided, however,
- 15 that grand jurors shall be entitled to mileage for travel
- 16 from the place of their residence to the county seat for the
- 17 purpose of being impaneled. No grand juror shall receive
- 18 mileage for travel in the performance of his duties when he
- 19 travels in a vehicle for which another juror is receiving
- 20 mileage.

### EXPLANATION

22 This bill increases the fees to be paid petit jurors to  
23 \$10 per day and grand jurors to \$12 per day.
