A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the movement of truck trailers manufactured
2 in this state.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
4 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one E point ten
5 (321E.10), Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:
6 321E.10 TRUCK TRAILERS MANUFACTURED IN IOWA. The state
7 highway commission or local authorities may in their discretion
8 and upon application issue annual trip permits for the movement
9 of truck trailers manufactured or assembled in this state that
10 exceed the maximum length specified in section 321.457 and the
11 maximum width specified in section three hundred twenty-one
12 point four hundred fifty-four (321.454) of the Code. Movement
13 of such truck trailers shall be solely for the purpose of
14 delivery or transfer from the point of manufacture or assembly
15 to another point of manufacture or assembly within the state or
16 to a point outside the state, shall be only on roadways of
17 twenty-four feet or more in width or on four-lane highways, shall
18 be on the most direct route necessary for delivery such move-
19 ment, and shall display the special plates designated in section
20 321.57. All truck trailers under permit for delivery such
21 movement shall contain no freight or additional load. All truck
22 trailers under permit for delivery such movement shall be at a
23 speed not to exceed forty-five miles an hour or the established
24 speed limit whichever is lower. No vehicle or combination of
25 two or more vehicles inclusive of front and rear bumpers, includ-

1 ing towing units, involved in the delivery movement of truck
2 trailers shall exceed ~~sixty-five~~ seventy feet in length and an
3 overall width of ten feet. All such vehicles or combinations
4 shall be distinctly marked on both the front and rear of the
5 unit in such manner as the commissioner of public safety shall
6 designate to indicate that the vehicles or combinations are
7 being moved for delivery or transfer purposes only.

8 Permits issued under the provisions of this section shall be
9 in writing and shall be carried in the cabs of the vehicles for
10 which the permits have been issued and shall be available for
11 inspection at all times. The vehicles for which the permits
12 have been issued shall be open to inspection by any peace
13 officer or to any authorized agent of any permit granting
14 authority.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill provides for the movement on the highways of
17 this state of truck trailers not exceeding 70 feet in length
18 and 10 feet in width manufactured in the state. The present
19 law allows delivery from the point of manufacture or assembly
20 to a point outside the state. This bill also allows the
21 movement of truck trailers from the point of manufacture or
22 assembly to another point of manufacture or assembly.
