A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the movement of vehicles and loads of exces-
2 sive size and weight under permit during daylight hours and
3 holidays.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

5 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one E point eleven
6 (321E.11), Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:

7 321E.11 DAYLIGHT MOVEMENT ONLY--HOLIDAYS. Movements by per-
8 mit in accordance with this chapter shall be permitted only
9 during ~~daylight~~ the hours from sunrise to sunset unless it is
10 established by the issuing authority that the movement can be
11 better accomplished at another period of time because of traffic
12 volume conditions.

13 Except as provided in section 321.457, no movement ~~of over-~~
14 ~~dimension-vehicles by permit~~ shall be permitted ~~on Saturday, Sun-~~
15 ~~day, holidays, or days preceding and following holidays~~ after
16 twelve o'clock noon on Saturdays, Sundays, or holidays or after
17 twelve o'clock noon on days preceding holidays and holiday
18 weekends, or special events when abnormally high traffic volumes
19 can be expected. Such restrictions shall not be applicable to
20 urban transit systems as defined in section 386C.1. For the
21 purposes of this chapter, holidays shall include New Years Day,
22 Memorial Day, Independence Day, Veterans Day, Labor Day, Thanks-
23 giving Day, and Christmas Day.

24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill provides for the movement of over-dimensional vehicles

1 during the hours from sunrise to sunset, instead of daylight
2 hours. The bill also lists the holidays when movement of over-
3 dimensioned vehicles is prohibited.

13 volume conditions.

14 Except as provided in section 321.457, no movement [of over-
15 dimension vehicles] *by permit* shall be permitted on [Saturdays,]
16 Sundays, holidays, [or days preceding and following holidays] *after*
17 *twelve o'clock noon on Saturdays,* or after
18 *twelve o'clock noon on days preceding holidays and holiday*
19 *weekends,* or special events when abnormally high traffic volumes
20 can be expected. Such restrictions shall not be applicable to
21 urban transit systems as defined in section 386C.1. *For the*
22 *purposes of this chapter, holidays shall include New Years Day,*
23 *Memorial Day, Independence Day, Veterans Day, Labor Day, Thanks-*
24 *giving Day, and Christmas Day.*

3 ing new section, and renumbering the remaining section.

4 Sec. _____. Section three hundred twenty-one point four
5 hundred fifty-seven (321.457), subsection six (6), Code 1973
6 is amended to read as follows:

7 6. No combination of three vehicles coupled together one
8 of which is a motor vehicle, unladen or with load, shall
9 have an ~~over-all~~ overall length, inclusive of front and rear
10 bumpers in excess of ~~sixty~~ sixty-five feet.

11 A combination of three vehicles in excess of sixty feet
12 but not in excess of sixty-five feet may be operated only
13 as follows:

14 a. On four-lane highways or on highways other than four-
15 lane highways when moving to or from a point within five
16 miles, on the most direct route, of a four-lane highway.

17 b. On other highways designated by the state highway
18 commission.
