A BILL FOR

1 An Act to increase the fees for applications, renewals and
2 reinstatements of registered architects.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

4 Section 1. Section one hundred eighteen point eleven
5 (118.11), Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:

6 118.11 FEES. The fee ~~to-be~~ paid to the board by an
7 applicant for an examination under this chapter shall be ~~ten~~
8 forty dollars. The fee ~~to-be~~ paid to the board by an applicant
9 for a certificate of registration as a registered architect
10 shall be fifteen dollars.

11 The fee ~~to-be~~ paid to the board for renewal of a certifi-
12 cate shall be ~~fifteen~~ twenty-five dollars.

13 All fees provided for by this chapter shall be paid to
14 and receipted for by the treasurer of state, who shall keep
15 such moneys in a separate fund, to be known as the fund of
16 the board of architectural examiners and shall not be used
17 for ~~any-purposes~~ a purpose other than the purposes of this
18 chapter. ~~Any~~ A balance remaining in such fund at the end
19 of each fiscal year in excess of fifteen thousand dollars
20 or the expenses of the board of such fiscal year, whichever
21 sum is the larger, shall be paid into the general fund of
22 the state.

EXPLANATION

24 This bill raises the application, renewal, and reinstatement
25 fees charged the board of architectural examiners.
