1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of
2 the state for the period of time commencing with the effective
3 date of this Act and ending June 30, 1973, to the board of
4 architectural examiners, the sum of two thousand eight hundred
5 ninety-one dollars and sixty cents (\$2,891.60), or so much
6 thereof as is necessary, to be used by the board of architec-
7 tural examiners to carry out the provisions of chapter one
8 hundred eighteen (118) of the Code.

9 Sec. 2. Section one hundred eighteen point eleven (118.11),
10 Code 1973, is amended to read as follows:

11 118.11 FEES. The fee to be paid to the board by an
12 applicant for an examination under this chapter shall be ten
13 dollars. The fee to be paid to the board by an applicant for
14 a certificate of registration as a registered architect shall
15 be fifteen dollars.

16 The fee to be paid to the board for renewal of a certificate
17 shall be fifteen dollars.

18 All fees provided for by this chapter shall be paid to and
19 receipted for by the treasurer of state, who shall keep such
20 moneys in a separate fund, to be known as the fund of the
21 board of architectural examiners and shall not be used for any
22 purposes other than the purposes of this chapter. Any balance
23 remaining in such fund at the end of each fiscal year ~~in excess~~
24 ~~of fifteen thousand dollars or the expenses of the board of~~
25 ~~such fiscal year, whichever sum is the larger,~~ shall be paid
26 ~~into the general fund of the state~~ carried forward and be
27 subject to expenditure by the board in the next fiscal year.
